

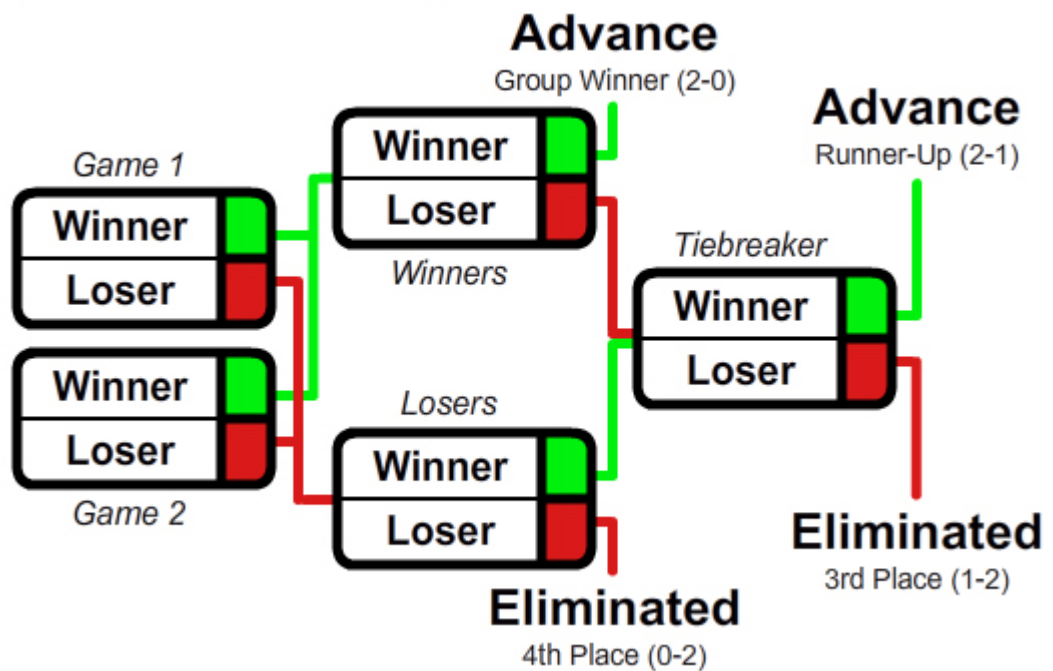
TTÜ e-Sport Autumn 2017 Hearthstone rules

1. General rules

- The game master can make changes in the ruleset and make decisions not established in the ruleset.
- Each participant must be acquainted with the tournament rules and overall LAN rules.
- By participating in the tournament, the players agree to said rules.
- Prior to the start of the tournament, all participants must submit 4 decklist (all with different heroes) to the tournament administration. Players are not required to revealed their decklist to their opponents.
- Every participant is required to submit the Hearthstone EU Battletag (nickname#number e.g. Gamer#1234).
- Participants must use the game account that they submitted during registration.

2. Group stage

- The group stage will be held in a GSL Group Format, with 4 participants per group playing best-of-five. The top-2 participants of each group will advance to playoff.
- Match format: Conquest BO5 Standard mode (Year of the Mammoth) with 1 ban
- GSL group format explained:



d. Conquest explained:

All matches will be best-of-5. The first player to win 3 games within the match is considered the winner of the match and advances.

- i. Each player must submit decklists from four unique classes prior to each stage of the event. Players may submit new decks prior to each stage of the event.
- ii. A player must win one game with each of his three decks to win the match.
- iii. When a player wins a game, the deck used by the winning player cannot be used for the remainder of the match.
- iv. The losing player can keep the same deck used or switch to a different one of their choice.
- v. Players will be told what classes their opponent has available, but they won't know which class is picked until both players have picked.

3. Playoff

- a. Playoff format: Single Elimination, with 3rd place match.
- b. Match format: Conquest BO5 Standard mode (Year of the Mammoth) with 1 ban.

4. Using Coach

- a. Coach can communicate with player before the beginning of match.
- b. During BO5 it is forbidden for coach to communicate with player.
- c. Coach can spectate player from ingame or behind back.
- d. Ingame spectation applies also rule 4 point b.
